divorced from him. Your Oratrix has
not cohabited with her said husband since
she knew of his being false to her.

Being without remedy at law your Oratrix
comes into Equity and prays that the said
Robt Brewster be made a party defendant
to this bill and be required to answer same
but not under oath, & that your Oratrix
be granted a divorce a vinculo

matrimonial, And your Oratrix prays
for all such other further and general
relief as the nature of her Case may
require and to Equity and good Conscience
may seem meet &c.
